## PREFACE

Proceedings Interbull Technical workshop, March 9-10, 2007, Paris, France.

The main purpose of Interbull Technical workshops is to address technical questions pertinent to international evaluations and development in Interbull services, and to provide a forum for a vivid discussion between participants from the Interbull member organizations.

The workshop in Paris dealt entirely with beef genetic evaluations.
